The qualifications of voter at an Annual School District Meeting are as follows: Every U.S. citizen age 18 or older who has resided in an election district or ward for 28 consecutive days before any election where the citizen offers to vote is an eligible elector.

 - a. Presentation of the 2018-2019 proposed budget tax levy and budget for all funds. The school board proposes \$6,276,964 as the school tax levy to provide \$4,683,063 for the General Fund, \$1,493,901 for Debt Service Fund, and \$100,000 for the Community Service Fund.
- 9. Consider the following resolutions:
 - a. Resolution to recommend the proposed 2018-2019 school budget
 - b. Resolution to authorize the School Board, during the current school year, to sell and dispose of any tangible personal property belonging to the school district that is determined by the school board to be longer needed for school purposes, provided however, that the maximum aggregate value of such tangible personal property disposed of shall not exceed \$5000 value evidenced by an independent appraisal and/or competitive bids when practical.
