

## RELEASE TIME FOR STUDENTS INCLUDING RELIGIOUS PURPOSES

There shall be no release time for students in the District unless they are participating in an approved curriculum-based, community-based program, 340 Release Program or for religious purposes as specified in state law. "Release time" includes any on-going release to leave school early or arrive late as well as release from study halls.
