## **SCHOOL DISTRICT OF NEW HOLSTEIN**

### 2017 Summer Elementary School Course Selections:

**Advanced Art:** (grades 4-8) Advanced Arts will give you the opportunity to explore the creative design of two and three-dimensional form. From tessellations to sculpture you will have the opportunity to experience the elements and principles of design through extensive projects. 1 hour class. \$10.00 fee (Offered 2nd and 3rd Hour)

**Archery:** (grades 5-8) Students will learn the components of the bow and arrow. They will learn the protocols of shooting safely and have a chance to play a variety of games while target shooting. 1 hour class. \$15.00 fee (Offered 3rd and 4th)

**Artist's Studio: NEW** (grade 5-8) It's an open studio, a maker's space! Studio centers allow for independent exploration and discovery. From cardboard construction, to drawing, painting or paper art, the choice is up to each creative artist. 1 hour class. \$15.00 fee (Offered 4th Hour)

**Basketball Fundamentals and Skills I:** (grades 3-6) This course introduces the fundamental skills of basketball. Emphasis will be placed on training, rules and skill development. 1 hour class No fee (Offered 1st hour)

**Basketball Shooting:** (grades 5-8) Class focus will be to improve your basketball shooting form. The class will include before and after video of your shooting form and drills the player can use to make the shooting changes permanent. 1 hour class. No fee (Offered 3rd and 4th Hour)

**Camp Read-a-Lot** (grades KG-2nd) Grab your marshmallows, chocolate, graham crackers, books and sleeping bags because it's time for CAMPING! Come enjoy all the wonderful times of camping, picnics and the great outdoors through books, activities, cooking and much more. 1 hour class. \$5.00 fee (Offered 1st and 2nd hour)

**Coding Class (NEW):** (grades 3-5) This is a coding class that will blends online, self-guided, and self-paced tutorials with "unplugged" activities that require no computer at all! Students will learn; conditionals, algorithms, binary code, debugging, and societal impacts of computing. 1 hour class. \$3.00 fee.(Offered 3rd Hour)

**Cooking 1** (grades 1-4) Students will learn the preparation of snacks and simple food snacks. 1 hour class. \$13.00 fee. (Offered 1st, 2nd, 3rd, 4th)

**Creative Kindergarten:** incoming kindergarteners will explore math, literacy, and writing with summer themed arts and creativity. Students will learn and review phonics as well as enjoy interactive play with their peers. 1 hour class. \$ 4.00 fee (Offered 4th Hour)

**Discover Clay 1 (NEW):** (grades 3-5) Discover a love for clay with this beginner's class to clay hand-building. Students will create their own artist's signature stamp, experiment with different textures on clay pinch pots, and create a slab mug and a coiled bowl. (Advanced students are also welcome into this session to develop their own ideas and inspire beginner students).  
1 hour class. \$15.00 fee ( Offered 1st Hour)

**Hand Sewing Hobbies** (incoming grades 4-8) This fun class allows the student to explore and experience many kinds of hand sewing techniques to develop new hobbies. Projects may include cross stitch, needlepoint, knitting, latch hook, embroidery and plastic canvas. All materials will be provided. 1 hour class. \$9.00 fee (Offered 2nd Hour)

You will make food, Harry Potter crafts, and if you work very hard, you may be named a prefect or Head Boy or Girl! **Kindergarten Readiness** (Incoming Kindergarteners) This class is designed to enrich the student's' readiness for entry into the 5 year-old Kindergarten classroom in the fall through a variety of fun activities and games. 3 hour class. \$ 6.00 fee (Offered 1st - 3rd Hours)

**LEGO Learning** (grades 5K-2) Students will read early reader LEGO books and create Lego figures by following directions. Students will create patterns, follow directions, make graphs, and solve math problems using Legos. Students will also have the opportunity to create their own Lego figures, take pictures and write to describe the LEGO figures. 1 hour class. \$10.00 fee. (Offered 1st, 2nd, 3rd, and 4th Hour)

**Lego building and beyond:** (grades 2-5) This is a course for those children who enjoy taking things apart and putting them back together. Children will have the opportunity to build with a

variety of different mediums. Ultimately, the class will work together to build Rube Goldberg Machines.(like the game Mousetrap). 1 hour class. \$10.00 fee. (Offered 3rd and 4th Hour)

**Let's Get Active!** (grades 1-3) Playing creatively with a partner, or a group, is what participants of this class will be engaged in. Students will learn many new and creative ways to play games that involve exercising bodies as well as imaginations. Some of the examples of activities include: Outrageous Obstacle Course, Baggyball, Roll out the Marble, Sea Urchin Soccer, Under-the-Sea Tag, Sponge Brigade and more. 1 hour class. \$5.00 fee (Offered 3rd and 4th Hour)

**Make it Homemade!** (grades 4-8) Students will learn the old fashion way of making items such as jelly, soap, candles, and more. They will learn the history and origin of which they were started and how they were made, as well as making items that can be used at home. 1 hour class. \$15.00 fee. (Offered 1st Hour)

**Math for Incoming 4th Graders:** (grade 3) Students will work on drills of basic facts and review problem solving learned in third grade. Emphasis will be placed on manipulatives will be used. 1 hour class. \$8.00 fee (Offered 2nd Hour)

**Math for Incoming 5th Graders:** (grade 4) Students will work on drills of basic facts and review problem solving learned in third grade. Emphasis will be placed on manipulatives will be used. 1 hour class. \$8.00 fee (Offered 1st Hour)

**Nature Studies** (grades 1-3) Students travel outside the school building to study birds, plants, trees insects, and water life. 1 hour class. \$3.00 fee (Offered 4th Hour)

**Pre-First Grade** (grade 5K) This class is designed for students entering first grade. Focus is on activities that will prepare students for entering First Grade (i.e. reading, writing, math, art, and computers) 4 Hour Class. \$10.00 Fee (Offered 1st-4th Hours)

**Reading Success for Incoming 2nd Graders:** (grade 1) This class is designed to help build reading strategies and skills for incoming 2nd graders. Students work with themed magazines packed with highly visual nonfiction articles and literary fiction. **Sewing 1** (incoming grades 1-2) This beginning sewing class will have everyone using the sewing machine and sewing by hand. A variety of fun, unique sewing projects will be made. All materials are provided. 1 hour class. \$9.00 fee (Offered 1st Hour)

**Sewing II**(incoming grades 3-4) Students will be making 3 projects using both the sewing machine and hand sewing. All materials will be provided. No previous sewing experience necessary. 1 hour class. \$9.00 fee (Offered 1st Hour)

**Sewing for Fun 1**(incoming grades 2-4) In this sewing lab, we will be making projects using the sewing machine and hand stitching. A variety of sewing projects will be sewn according to the students’ interests and age levels. All materials are supplied. 1 hour class. \$9.00 fee (Offered 3rd and 4th Hours)

**Space Science**(grades 1-2) This class is available for students interested in learning about “infinity and beyond”. Students will learn about planets, stars, and the sun in our universe using a variety of books and fun projects. 1 hour class. \$3.00 fee (Offered 1st Hour)

**Spanish for Beginners - NEW!** (grades 1-5th) Students will be introduced to Spanish vocabulary for beginners. Some of the topics that will be taught are, numbers, colors, animals, forms of greetings, cultural awareness, likes, dislikes and food items. 1 hour class. \$5.00 fee (Offered 1st, 2nd, 3rd, and 4th Hours)

**Team Sports 1 (grades 2 - 4)** Students will be offered a variety of organized team sports including soccer, baseball, kickball, dodgeball, and more. 1 hour class. \$5.00 fee (Offered 2nd, 3rd & 4th hour)

rock, Latin, and swing styles of music. This class is for the beginning and intermediate jazz players. (Offered 2nd Hour)

**Knitting with plastic forms- NEW!** (grades 6-8) This course will allow students to create scarves, hats, blankets or potholders using a plastic form to help create the masterpiece. Students will provide their own yarn. No fee. (Offered 1st Hour)

**Make it Homemade** (grades 4-8) Student will learn the old fashion way of making items such as jelly, soap, candles, and more. They will learn the history and origin of which they were started and how they were made, as well as making items that can be used at home. 1 hour class. \$13.00 fee. (Offered 1st Hour)

**Math for Incoming 6th Graders** (grades 6) Students will review basic facts and review problem solving learned in fifth grade. Emphasis will be placed on dividing and multiplying two digit factors, fractions, as well as measurement. Math games, puzzles, and technology will be used. 1 hour class. \$8.00 fee (Offered 2nd Hour)

**Math for Incoming 7 & 8th Graders** (grades 7 & 8) Students will review basic facts and review problem solving learned in Middle School. Emphasis will be placed on remedial skills needed to become more successful in all Middle School class by use of technology. 1 hour class. \$8.00 fee (Offered 1st Hour)

**Reading Success for 7th and 8th Graders:** This class is designed to help build reading strategies and skills for middle schoolers. Students will work on vocabulary and word study, comprehension strategies, reading logs, and writing. 1 hour class. \$8.00 fee (Offered 4th Hour)

**Rocketry** (grades 4-8) Students will have “hands-on” experience building their own rockets. Rockets will be launched and recovered. 1 hour class. \$15.00 fee. (Offered 3rd and 4th Hour)

**Sewing 3:** (incoming grades 5-8) In this course students will make various projects using the sewing machine and hand sewing. Advanced techniques will be taught for sewing using the sewing machine and hand sewing. Projects will be decided by class interest and experience. All materials are supplied. 1 hour class. \$9.00 fee (Offered 2nd Hour)

**Sewing for Fun 2** (incoming grades 5-8) In this sewing lab, we will be making projects using the sewing machine and hand stitching. A variety of sewing projects will be sewn according to the students’ interests and age levels. All materials are supplied. 1 hour class. \$9.00 fee (Offered 3rd and 4th Hour)

**Strategy Games Creation :** (grades 5-8) Combine your storytelling creativity with love of all things games! During our weeks together, we will be researching some board-based strategy games the best way there is: by playing them together. Then, we will create our own games and

play them with and against each other. The games we create and study will be at varying levels of skill and difficulty, but everyone will have fun playing. 1 hour class. \$5.00 fee. (Offered 1st, 2nd, 3rd, and 4th hour)

**Team Sports 2** (grades 5-8) Students will be offered a variety of organized team sports including soccer, baseball, kickball, dodgeball, and more. 1 hour class. \$5.00 fee. (Offered 2nd, 3rd, and 4th Hour)

**Theater and Drama** (grades 4-8) Students will have an opportunity to learn about the theater through a variety of different techniques. The format of the class will be movement type games. Students should come dressed to move around and to have fun while learning different ways to improve their acting abilities. **Upcycled Art- NEW!** (grades 5-8) Student will create artistic projects, for example, pictures frames, lanterns, etc. using everyday materials such as, soup cans, cereal boxes, 2 liter bottles, beads, etc. \$3.00 fee. (Offered 2nd, 3rd, and 4th Hour)

**Volleyball Fundamentals** Volleyball Fundamentals (Incoming freshmen) - This is a three hour rigorous course where students learn volleyball skills and systems used at higher levels. Expect to improve your Volleyball Skills if you take this course. Register early as space may be limited. (Offered Hours 1 - 3)

**Walking Club** :- (Grade 4-8) Students will walk, jog and/or run using pedometers. Steps will be measured each day to see how far around the United States they can "travel" in this 5 week period. Students will learn about geography by using maps of Wisconsin and the United States, as well as the benefits of exercise and how to make lifestyle changes for a long and healthy life! 1 hour class. ## **2017 Summer High School Course Selections:**

**Exploring German-NEW!** This course is a great beginning curriculum for high school students of all ages who have never studied German before. Students will meet for two hours per day during the four weeks of summer school. Class will begin at 8:00 and go until 10:00. No fee.

**AP U.S. History Prep-NEW!** This course would help students enrolled in AP US History develop the skills needed to handle a college level workload and gain a better understanding of time management. Students will develop writing and critical thinking skills as well.

### **2017 Supervised Agricultural Experience (SAE):**

This course is designed to reflect one of the three essential components of an agricultural education program. This specialized course is designed for those students aspiring to further develop their Supervised Agricultural Experience. The emphasis of this course is on hands-on learning and applying lessons to meet the needs of all students. Students in this course will work directly with the Agriscience Department. This summer independent study course includes putting together activity-based lessons relating to the SAEs of the enrolled students. Some of the areas that lessons will focus around will be: Dairy Production, Beef Production, Poultry Production, Sheep Production, Horticultural Science, Food Science / Agricultural Processing, Agricultural Education, Agriscience Applications, Agribusiness, Landscape Management, Crop Science, and many any other agricultural applications students wish to pursue.

This is an Independent Study class, the students will need to record a minimum of 90 hours during the summer with their projects in order meet the 90 hour requirement for a 1/2 credit in Agriculture. This class will also be graded on a pass/fail grade and not a regular letter grade. Please see **Joe Heinbach** with any questions and/or to sign up for the class.

### **AP English summer school description:**

In an effort to maximize the AP English curriculum, incoming AP Language and Composition seniors need to participate in the summer school program. All students will pick up their materials before the end of their junior year and follow the prescribed assignments including, but not exclusive to: vocabulary development, reading a novel that will be used throughout the AP program, and complete four (4) college prep writing assignments. All work will have descriptive assignments, a sample of support, and requirement to meet with the instructor at four checkpoints throughout the summer.

All assignments will need to be turned in by the assigned dates and grades will be reflected in the first quarter grading period.

**This is a blended class, so students will meet on four mandatory sessions:**

Monday, June 12, 2017 in room 223 9:00-12:00

Monday, July 10, 2017 in room 223 9:00-12:00

Monday, August 7, 2017 in room 223 9:00-12:00

Monday, August 21, 2017 in room 223 9:00-12:00

In addition, students will work independently on writing assignments and then meet with the teacher during scheduled office hours to hone their writing craft.

**AP Literature and Composition Prep work- NEW!** Students taking AP Lit & Comp in the 2017/18 school year will need to take this class to begin background work needed for the class. We will meet four mornings throughout the summer from 9-11:30 to build the needed skills/knowledge to succeed. Students will begin working on vocabulary, reading and analyzing a variety of literature, writing craft and structure, and writing an interpretation of a literary work.

### **Drivers Education**
