Welcome to the wonderful world of 4 year old kindergarten education! We are excited about partnering with you to begin your child's learning adventure.

For the 2026-2027 school year, the New Holstein School District is pleased to offer **wrap-around care through Husky Den at no hourly charge** for 4K families. Families will pay a **\$15 registration fee**, which covers care from **7:30 a.m. to 3:15 p.m., Monday through Friday.**

What does this mean for your family?

- If your child attends **morning 4K**, they may stay for **Husky Den in the afternoon at no additional cost**. If they attend afternoon 4K they may attend Husky Den in the Morning for no additional cost.
- 4K families also have the opportunity to attend **Husky Den on Wednesdays**.
- Care **before 7:30 a.m. or after 3:15 p.m.** is available at the regular hourly rate.

Enclosed is the enrollment information for the New Holstein Elementary School 4-year-old Kindergarten program, 2026-2027 school year. To enroll in 4K, your child **must** be four years old on or before September 1<sup>st</sup>, 2026. It is recommended that your child is fully potty trained prior to entering 4K.

Please fill out the enclosed forms and return them to the New Holstein Elementary School during in person registration February 16th - February 20th, 8:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. If you cannot make it during those hours, please call the elementary office to make an appointment at 920-898-4208. You can also drop them off in the office anytime between 7:30 am and 3:30 pm Monday-Friday.

You will need to bring in your child's birth certificate to verify his/her birthdate and a proof of address such as a utility bill. Our elementary school is located at: 2226 Park Avenue, New Holstein.

The New Holstein School District 4K classes run Monday, Tuesday, Thursday and Friday - mornings 8:00-11:00 am and afternoons 12:00-3:00 pm. Placement is determined by bus routes and class sizes.
