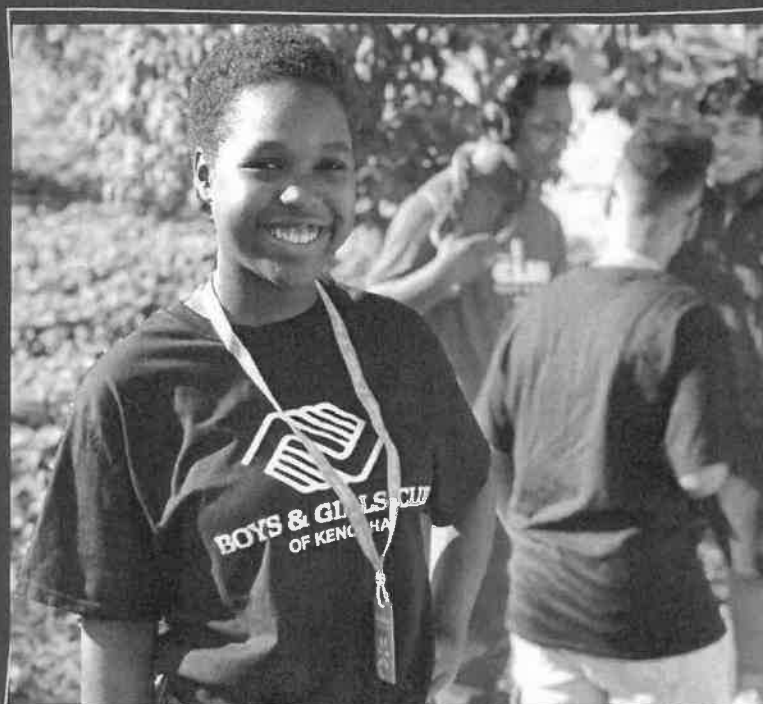

2027 Washington D.C. Trip Participation Contract

The goal of the New Holstein Middle School is to provide opportunities for students to experience a variety of learning situations that are available outside of the building. To promote maximum learning and enjoyment from participation in these travel activities, it is necessary to identify proper student behavior, conduct and academic expectations of all participants. These expectations will govern all aspects of the trip, participation on the trip, and the ability to go on the trip. Students are required to behave in a manner where they will represent their family, school and community in a positive manner.

Requirements for Participation

Academic Expectations:

1. Passing grades in all class at any grading period (quarter for quarter classes, semester for semester classes)
2. Completed homework 90% of the time on time

Behavior Expectations

1. Get to class on time with fewer than 3 unexcused tardies for the year
2. Students will follow attendance expectations and stay within the State required 10 days absent for the school year
3. No suspensions
4. Two or fewer detentions or removals from class
5. Comply with all New Holstein School Policies or rules
6. No issues with law enforcement that result in a ticket or referral
7. Respectful to staff and peers
8. Respectful of the learning of others in the classroom

Service Hours Expectations

1. Student meets the 12 service hours requirement (6 hrs due 9/30, final 6 hrs due 12/19)
2. Student fills out and returns all required service hour paperwork to Mrs. Compton by due dates

If you can't behave at school, there is no reason to take you out of the State

Failure to Meet Expectations:

- Students who fail to meet participation expectations may be placed on probation or become ineligible for the trip.
- **Refund policies of the company if a student is removed from the trip due to disciplinary or academic reasons will apply.**

Procedure for removal from trip (pre-departure):

1. Step 1: Warning; Parent will be notified of possible removal from trip verbally and in writing and a meeting will be established between the parents, child, and administration. This step may be in conjunction with Step 2 or 3 if an incident is considered egregious as determined by administration. Students will receive no more than two warnings but can be less.
2. Step 2: Parents will be required to attend the trip with student (if room is available) and the parent is responsible for the additional cost to do so. Parent will room with the child if an overnight trip and will maintain visual proximity with the child at all times. Parent will be solely responsible for their child for the duration of the trip. If the parent refuses, there is no room left on the trip, the parent cannot meet this obligation or if grades, safety, or space on the trip are an issue, then this process will move directly to step 3.
3. Step 3: Student will be removed from the trip and will not participate. Parents are encouraged to get refund insurance during trip sign up, however failure to do so will not be a factor in the decision to remove or not remove a student from the trip.
4. Movement through these steps is based on school policy and administrative discretion.

Procedure for discipline while on the trip

1. Step 1: Conference with the student about behavior and steps needed to rectify the situation
2. Step 2: Assigned to an adult for the remainder of the trip. Student must stay within visual contact with that adult while on tour and will sit with the adult while on the bus. Parents will be contacted.
3. Step 3: Student will stay on the bus with an adult and will no longer be allowed to participate in tour events other than meals. Must remain with an adult at all times. Parent will be contacted.
4. Step 4: Student will be sent home. Parent must come get the student at their own expense.
5. Egregious or illegal acts, as determined by administration, can affect the sequence of these steps.

I agree to and understand all the above requirements for academics and behavior in order to participate in the Washington D.C. Trip. My signature below, and that of my parent, signifies my agreement to follow the rules outlined above and the discipline resulting from failure to follow expectations. I also understand with my signature that I will be moved to the waitlisted if this form is not signed and turned into the office by October 15, 2026 and removed from the trip if this is not signed and returned by October 31, 2026.
