New Holstein Elementary School 4K Extended Care and Before & After School Program

Welcome to the New Holstein Elementary School Husky Den Program. The Husky Den is an extended care program that offers a safe, organized and positive environment for children to socialize, develop character building skills, and think creatively. This program is offered to families in the New Holstein School District who have children enrolled in grades 4K-5. The program is located at the New Holstein Elementary School.

PROGRAM PURPOSE: The purpose of the Husky Den is to provide each child with a safe, organized and positive environment that encourages them to develop their academic skills as well as the ability to socialize in a controlled atmosphere.

STAFF: We have a fully qualified staff that will provide strong leadership and an enriching environment for constant growth and success. The staff's goal is for each child to feel successful about their accomplishments.

HOURS OF OPERATION: We are open M-F every week of school year except for Holidays (Thanksgiving, Christmas and Easter) including teacher in service days.

4K Students-- Husky Den is offered from 8AM-12PM and 11AM-3PM on Monday, Tuesday, Thursday and Friday and is offered on Wednesdays from 8AM-2PM.

Before and After Care—Husky Den is offered from 6-7:30AM and 3-6PM for 4K-5th grade students on Monday, Tuesday, Thursday and Friday and is offered on Wednesdays 6-7:30AM and 2-6PM to accommodate early release day.

TUITION: There is a onetime **FAMILY** registration of \$15 and the fee is \$3 per hour per child billed and paid bi-monthly after the first two weeks of care.
