Content Areas:

Math:

- 1 - 3 ring binder (1 ½ inch with side pockets)
- 1 pk of 5 tab dividers
- 1- ruler(English and Metric)
- 1- calculator (TI-30Xa Scientific is available in the school store.) Mandatory to have a calculator in 6th grade. It will be used 6th-8th grade.**

- 1 pk of 5 tab dividers
- 1- folder with side pockets
- 1- notebook or pack(s) of looseleaf paper
- 1- composition notebook

Art:

- Art smock (optional)
- #2 pencils with erasers
- Black Sharpie

Physical Education: Phy. Ed. shorts & T-shirt

Choir:

- 1 inch BLACK binder with no clear outside pockets
- #2 pencils with erasers
