## Dear Parents/Guardians:

Due to our concerts being in the gymnasium though, please remember that audience behavior is different at a concert than an athletic event. The students practice hard and are extremely proud being performers on stage; please keep the following statements in mind so that we may all have an enjoyable concert.

- Remain seated and quiet when the performance is in progress.
- If your child is not on stage performing, please still listen and be thoughtful to those around you who do have a child on stage.
- If it is necessary to leave the gymnasium before the concert is over, please do so between numbers.
- Since there are bright lights on stage it's very hard for the students to see the audience, therefore refrain from calling out your child's name.
- Clapping is the appropriate way to show appreciation for the performance rather than whistling or cheering.
- Parents should keep small children seated with them on the bleachers or the chairs.
- When taking pictures or video, remain seated so others around you can still see.
